## Larger Group Sessions - these notes apply to Variations 2023 and will be updated for the 2024 course

The larger group sessions are changing format this year following feedback from the 2022 course. We have arranged two coached afternoon sessions for strings and wind groups separately, but we encourage you to arrange your own string, wind or mixed strings and wind groups for the other afternoon sessions.

The two afternoon sessions for string players will work on the Haydn String Quartet Opus 33 no 3. The first session, on Sunday, will concentrate on the 1<sup>st</sup> movement and the second, on Tuesday, will focus on the 3<sup>rd</sup> movement although there may be time to look at other movements as well. This will be worked on as a string orchestra rather than quartet and each section will be led by someone appointed to the role. As always, you will be encouraged to express your own ideas, but tutors will also be available to coach and advise.

Wind players are encouraged form larger groups at the same time. We have 13 players in total, double wind quintet plus two additional flutes and one clarinet. Krys and Fiona will be bringing a selection of music for larger wind groups but please also bring your own scores and parts for works you would like to play.
